When the going gets tough...the tough pray for guidance...and contentment. September has been a month of "lack" at C4KK (our children's home). Our donations dropped like they never have before. It caused us to cancel the tutors we usually have (which has upset the class 8 students who are to take the national exam this term). Tammy and I spent our personal monthly allocation filling needs so single moms and abandoned kids would continue to eat, go to school and get medical attention...the needs actually grew. In the midst of this we brought two more children into our family who were in a bad way and we couldn't wait. I tell you this not to get a "poor Chuck" from you. I tell you this to tell you it just made me go to the Lord even more and find the contentment in Jesus the Apostle Paul talks about. I remind myself daily that my life, actually life itself, is all about God. He has it all under control in His infinite wisdom...nothing surprises Him. If I truly believe that, what is the big deal things are not going as I would like. The question is "Am I continuing to be faithful through every and all circumstances?" If I am simply doing that I am doing my part...I must let God do His. Jesus gave us the example of what we are supposed to do in life...it is strewn throughout Scripture. It is times like this we come closer to God and must simply rely on Him through the tears, the pain, and we can come, by His grace, to the point of being content in all circumstances.

Cows, cows, cows....did I say cows? We need another cow. I have personally checked out some cows and have found the ones we need. As I mentioned in the last newsletter we need approximately \$2,500 for this cow. The cow is called a Fleckvieh and will produce around 30 liters a day by herself. For example, literally as I write this letter we have just assisted in getting a 2 year old little girl out of the hospital after she was in there for a month because her single mom could not pay the bill so the hospital kept her while continuing to assess daily fees. She left today with her mom crying tears of joy and thanking God for His providence. This fund has approximately \$400/month being contributed to it...we would like to get this to \$1,000 monthly. Can you help us get children out of hospital prison, how about eat for a few days to keep them literally from starving, what about saving a life by getting a little one into the hospital...I could go on. I said yes to Him when He asked me to give everything away to serve Him, not knowing how or what that would be or how He was going to get it done. Now I know He was going to do it through a partnership of His people to glorify Him and serve His children. I pray for you daily and thank Him for that partnership which He created and His will which is done. Please pray with me that our partnership will continue to be a faith filled one which honors Him and serves His people faithfully. My love to you through our amazing God and King, our Lord Jesus Christ.
