Now I don't say you should take all of your grievances to the public until you have talked to the person and attempted to bring the brother or sister back to Christ, but eventually the issues, if evil and continuing, must be brought out into the light so they can be stopped. This happened to me this month and something that was being pursued in the dark against me was brought into the light...once in the light it was resolved.

Think about it, what is the evil one's mode of operation...keep it in the dark. Either through keeping individuals ignorant or keeping things hidden, evil can continue forward. You can't really imagine what needs to be done when you are leaving for such a long time and by our Lord's grace have been loving 29 kids...it takes a lot. Please understand I totally know the Lord has brought us to where we are and He will stand in the gap while we are gone, but I also know He brought us here because of who we are and how we could handle situations in a poverty based, corrupt country. We have stepped out in many circumstances where our kids were at risk at our own peril...that is not the normal way in Kenya. We have been working with the people here so they will work together and stand together when any one is being attacked by outsiders who wish to hurt the kids for money or simply to exercise their power. I am praying while we are gone God continues to bind satan in all things and He will continue to be our strong defender as life continues no matter where we are. Our confidence in Him is because we know our Lord, and no matter what is happening we know He hears the cry of His children....everything will be o.k....I have just got to get that totally into my being so I can leave in peace....content in all things.

No matter what happens to us or where we are we need to continue to partner with you...thanks for continuing your support. I talked to our banker this last month about what we needed to do to prepare in the event that Tammy and I are called to the Lord during this furlough...he and his assistant laughed. Since I found nothing funny about this I inquired why he was laughing. He then saw we were serious and stopped. I again asked why he was laughing. He said these type of conversations made Kenya's nervous so they laugh as if it were a joke. I asked him why preparing for something which could happen would make him uncomfortable? He said it was simply the death aspect of it...I had another opportunity to preach the Gospel. I told him death does not bother me since I am confident in what Christ has said and

my faith is in Him. But I am also confident I should, and am called to, prepare for whatever comes so I can hear "Well done good and faithful son" become I made sure my kids would be taken care of in the event I go home to meet Him (faith with action). After that he called the bank's home office to find out what we should do to allow Bosco (our CEO in training) to continue to handle things on this end if Tammy and I meet the Lord together...it is now handled. We have assured the kids so their fears are less (can't get them to zero), but they do know God has miraculously brought them this far and He is not about to abandon them. I tell you this to encourage you to continue to support the mission and, if you haven't considered doing so, to pray about whether you are called to begin to do so. Just because Tammy and I may be with the Lord is no reason to stop your support of a mission which God started and continues to maintain through you. He is the One, not us, who has a plan...we just said "Yes Lord" and have moved by His grace. You can click here to support these kids through your prayerful partnership.
